Entry Fee: Each shower will be provided with a full 8' banquet table

- Entry fee is \$65 and includes all divisions.
- Limited to first 75 paid entrants. A wait list will be opened if required.
- A brief entry form will be provided prior to registration opening at 3 pm on Saturday, June 13, 2026. Entrants will be emailed a link to a JotForm to complete registration with lunch and other details.
- Payment will be accepted as check or PayPal F&F at mary.riordan@gmail.com.

Doors open at 7 am, show starts promptly at 8 am.

Definitions: For this show a custom is a mass-produced plastic or china model that has been cold painted in any medium, repositioned, etched, rehired, ect. Artist editions include resin, pewter, or 3D printed models. Medallions or busts of any material or scale that are cold painted are welcome in the appropriate medallion class. These classes are judged on workmanship only.

Limits: Two horses per entrant per class and each model may enter one class. Buy in additional class entries for \$1- place in front of model. No limits on Fun Classes.

No risers in classes.

Fantasy classes: Fantasy Equine eligibility is limited to equine based fantasy models such as: Equine Unicorns, Pegasus, Hippocampus, Hippogriff, Thestral, Zombie Horse, Skeletal Horse, or other fantasy equines which depict a creature that is at least 50% equine in form. Please see the NAMHSA official policies for more information. No partial human or humanoid creatures are allowed per their rules. These classes are Workmanship only.

Judging: All classes except medallions and fantasy will be double-judged for breed and workmanship, those other classes are workmanship only. NAN status will be updated once application is approved by NAMHSA. Judge's decisions are final. Classes may be split or combined. [PENDING APPROVAL: First- and second-place equids or approved fantasy animals in its OPEN classes qualify for NAN. An

open class is defined as competition where the entrant is not limited by skill level, age, or years of competition.]

Prizes: Flat paper ribbons 1-6, flat awards for sectional champ/reserves, rosettes for divisional champ/reserve, and special prizes.

Tags: Please put BREED and SEX on one side of tag or business card sized card and HORSE'S NAME and YOUR NAME or INITIALS on opposite side.

Documentation: Up to 8.5x11", but smaller is better to save table space. No books, please. Please do not document common colors and breeds.

Breed Categories: Please consult the Lesli Kathman's breed list. If unclear just ask.

Silent Auction: TBD depending on donations

Raffle: Accepting donations. Tickets will be sold on show day. Must be present at show to win.

Vendor Tables: Extra 8' banquet table for \$15. You may sell at your table if you have space and aren't impeding the walkways.

Lunch: A boxed lunch is available from the one site caterer for \$15 with a premium sandwich, drink, cookie and chips, but must be pre-ordered (details to come). Our contract with the venue/caterer does not allow outside food to be brought in.

Refunds: At discretion of show holder, but we cannot accommodate refunds for inclement weather or travel disruptions unless show is canceled/postponed.

COVID-19 Precautions: Local and state guidelines will be followed at time of event. Feel free to mask if desired or needed, but it will not be required at this time. If you are not feeling well please do not attend to avoid spreading illness among attendees.

Conduct: No running, horsing around, or touching models that don't belong to you without permission. You break it, you buy it. No alcohol allowed on premises due to insurance restrictions and safety. Please be respectful of judges and your fellow showers; anyone causing a disruption will be asked to leave without a refund. Smoking is not allowed inside the building.

Parking and Accessibility: There is ample free parking at the venue. The show hall is accessible via ramps and elevators.

Charitable Donation: All proceeds remaining after show expenses (including 100% of raffle and silent auction) are paid will be donated to Nobody's Cats. You may also make donations directly to them or at the show. Please check their website for current needs of non-monetary donations and I will collect them at the event.
